Open Gym Code of Conduct

MISSION:

“To provide opportunities that enhance healthy community connections.”

GROWTH VISION:

“Foster a supportive and constructive (work) environment that embraces Conservation, Social Equity, Health & Wellness through inclusive decision making and mindful daily actions.

When using facilities for or participation in, programs and activities managed by or allowed by South Burlington Recreation and Parks everyone is responsible for;

- Conducting themselves in a proper and socially acceptable manner.
- Exhibiting behavior that supports the health, safety and well-being of others.
- Refraining from the use of profanity or offensive language and ethnic slurs.
- Abstaining from any type of conduct intended to humiliate or intimidate others.
 - No Arguing! Excessive arguing (including arguing with your own teammates) and “trash talking” will not be tolerated. The first infraction, player is suspended from the current session and for the next two sessions of **any/all** Open Gym sessions. The second infraction, a player will have a one year suspension from the date of infraction. **A third infraction will equal life suspension from all Open Gym sessions with the South Burlington Recreation and Parks department.**
- Providing a drug free environment.
 - A zero tolerance policy will be in effect. Any player who attends an Open Gym session that appears to be under the influence of alcohol or an illegal substance will be suspended from all Open Gym sessions for a full year from the date of the offense.
- Abiding by all laws, rules, regulations and ordinances whether city, state or local.
- Open Gym activities are self-officiated by those attending.
- Any unsportsmanlike behavior before, during, or after a game should be brought to the attention of the volunteer coordinator, or a member of the South Burlington Recreation and Parks staff. Upon investigation and based on the severity of the act, the department reserves the right to impose an appropriate consequence, ranging from a verbal warning to life suspension.
- A blood borne pathogen rule is in effect.
